

# DAIRY FLAT SCHOOL AGRICULTURAL DAY

Traditionally, the emphasis of Ag Day is on the caring and rearing of a farm animal.

For Ag Day to continue to remain a successful, fun school day, please make an effort to rear an animal. There are other options to consider for those who are unable to raise an animal.

Judging Criteria for all categories is available on the school web site.

Students must enter either **one** category from **Section A** or **two** categories from **Section B**.

***REMEMBER - If you DO NOT raise an animal in SECTION A you must select 2 options in SECTION B to complete***

## **SECTION A**

### LAMB

Categories judged - leading & handling  
- most obvious pet  
- rearing & grooming

### CALF

Categories judged - leading & handling  
- rearing & grooming  
- beef or dairy type

### GOAT

Categories judged - leading & handling  
- most obvious pet  
- rearing & grooming

CHICKENS Raised from 1 day old (only those supplied by DFS can be entered)

Chickens will be judged on Ag Day

**Diaries** must be handed in to the school office before **Ag Day**

Caged Pet- Cannot be less than one month old and can have been to Ag day before.  
Comes with an information fact sheet on judging day

### **SECTION B**

**Mystery Seed** - This is made at home and must be brought to school  
**on Saturday Ag day by 8.30.** Refer to Judging Criteria for details.

**SCARECROW** - This is made at school **on Ag Day.** A \$4 fee is required to  
cover cost of wooden frame. Refer to Judging Criteria for details.

**BLOCK CONSTRUCTION**- This is made at home and must be  
displayed in the school hall before **8.45am FRIDAY before Ag Day**  
Refer to Judging Criteria for details.

In addition there are 3 in class activities which the teachers will let you know about closer to the time. They will request some resources from home to complete these activities.
